Article This scholarship is donated by Professor Po-ying Lin of our department.

1 Professor Po-ying Lin won the fifth "Dahsiao Award" presented by the "Mr. Wu Xiuqi Memorial Parents Cultural and Educational Foundation" in 1984, with a bonus of NT\$300,000. Professor Lin donated all the award money to serve as the scholarship/assistantship fund. The fund is kept in a specific account of the school. In 1993, the name was changed to "Scholarship and Assistantship for the Underprivileged, Department of English, NCCU" and is open to donations from all walks of life. The annual scholarship amount is paid from the department's surplus. In 1996, the name was changed to "Scholarship and Assistantship of Department of English, NCCU."

Article The scholarship is limited to first-, second-, third-, and fourth-year

undergraduate students and master program students in the department. Priority is given to undergraduate students for scholarships and assistantships.

Article Eligibility:

Applications for Assistantships

- 1. Those students in the undergraduate program who are either: with outstanding filial piety, with an underprivileged family background, physically or mentally challenged, or with any needs to help with family finances.
- 2. Those whose academic scores in the previous semester averaged above 70 and whose conduct scores were above 80 points.

Applications for Scholarships

- 1. Those whose academic scores in the previous semester were above 85 points and whose conduct scores were above 80 points.
- 2. Those who do not receive other scholarships from the department in this academic year.

- Article Quota: As a general rule, there will be five recipients of the scholarship each
 - 4 academic year. Preference will be given to those who have not benefited from other departmental scholarships in the current academic year. If the number of recipients is less than five, the remaining amount of money for that year will be used as the scholarship to encourage students with outstanding academic performances.
 - 1. Those who do not receive other scholarships from the department in this academic year.
- Article Award amount: The assistantship is NT\$10,000 per student and the scholarship is NT\$4,000 per student.
- Article Application Period: March 1st to March 31st every year.

Article Application procedures:

- 1. Complete the application form.
 - 2. Prepare transcripts with all previous years' grades, student conduct certificates, and grade ranking certificates.
 - 3. Submit the above forms to the department office before the designated date.
- Article Selection method: decided by the "Scholarship and Assistantship Review
 - 8 Committee" of the department.
- Article Scholarship Awarding Method:
 - After the list of winners is announced, the department office will make a record and remit the scholarships and assistantships to the student accounts.
- Article These Measures will be implemented after being adopted by the Department
 - 10 General Faculty Committee. The same applies to revisions.
